## **Tool List for Introductory Turning Workshops**

Each student should have:

Bowl Gouge 1/4" – 5/8"

Spindle Gouge 3/8" – 1/2"

Beading and Parting tool 1/8" - 1/2"

Notepad & Pencil

Face Shield or Safety Glasses (regular eyeglasses are not enough!)

Dust Mask

## **Equipment needed for the classroom:**

- Each student will need a Lathe, and I will want to have one to use for demonstrations.

-Class lathes should be equipped with a drive center, a tailstock live center, knock-out bar, tool rest, and a chuck.

-A grinder should be available for sharpening. Preferably one with Wolverine platform and good quality wheel(s), one coarse (like 50 grit) & one fine (80-120)

- I will bring the wood for the class

-We need a white board, chalk board, or flip chart to draw on during class
