## **Tool List for the Capsule Box with Inlay**

### **These are the tools that you need to make this box:**

Scroll Chuck that will hold about a 1 3/4"/45mm tenon  
1/8" (3mm) Parting Tool  
1/2" (13mm) (or similar) Bowl Gouge (or round Carbide cutter)  
Round Ended Scraper (HSS or Carbide)  
Square ended scraper  
Live and drive centers (smaller diameter ones are nice)  
Double sided tape

### **You will also need:**

Wood Blank (I'm using 2 1/2" x 4 1/2") (63mm x 114mm)  
Inlay Blank 3/8"/10mm thick and larger than the intended inlay. Flatten one side of the inlay.  
Jam Chuck Blank about the same diameter as the box blank

### **If you have them, here are more tools that are useful:**

Forstner Drill or Twist Drill, and Jacobs Chuck or StrongBore to hold it  
Vernier Caliper for scribing  
Wall Thickness Caliper  
Depth Gauge  
Ruler  
1/16" (1.5mm) Parting Tool  
3/8" (10mm) Beading and Parting Tool  
1/2" (13mm) wide Straight Side Flat Bottom Box Scraper  
3/8" (10mm) Spindle Gouge  
3/8" (10mm) Bowl Gouge  
1/2" (13mm) 50/50 Negative Rake Scraper or other angled scraper  
1/4" (6mm) Pyramid Tool  
1/2" (13mm) Square Recess Finishing Scraper  
Spindle Roughing Gouge  
Center Finder

Many different tools can be used to do the same jobs. It is not necessary to have all of these tools to make this project. Sometimes the tools we have determine what we turn.
