## **Tool List for the Hollow Vessel woodturning project**

These are the tools that I use to make the Hollow Vessel in the Demonstration:

- 1/16" Parting Tool
- 3/8" Beading and Parting Tool
- 1/2" 40/40 Bowl Gouge
- 1/2" Square Recess Finisher
- 1/2" Skew or other tool for creating dovetail tenon
- Negative Rake Scrapers
- Wall thickness caliper
- Vernier caliper (for transferring diameters)
- Depth Gauge
- Steb Centers for headstock and tailstock
- Tailstock center with large cone
- Forstner Bit for depth drilling
- Hollowing system
- Reversing fixture for doing the bottom
- Chuck with appropriate jaws for your vessel
- Sanding products, as needed
- Dyes, top coats, and other finishing products

Please note: It is not necessary to have all of these tools to make this project! These are what I used, but it is possible to make this piece without owning all of these tools.
