Tool List for the Tall Colored Hollow Vessel woodturning project

These are the tools that I use to make the Multi-Axis Hollow Vessel in the Demonstration:

3/4" Spindle Roughing Gouge
1/16" Parting Tool
3/8" Beading and Parting Tool
1/2" 40/40 Bowl Gouge
1/2" Square Recess Finisher
3/8" Finial Gouge
1/2" Skew or other tool for creating dovetail tenon
Figure 8 Caliper (for wall thickness)
Multi-radius large caliper (for wall thickness)
Vernier caliper (for transferring diameters)
Depth Gauge
Steb Centers for headstock and tailstock
Tailstock center with large cone
Forstner Bit for depth drilling
Hollowing system
Reversing fixture for doing the bottom
Chuck with deep jaws
TransTint Dyes, Embellishing Wax, spray lacquer

Please note: It is not necessary to have all of these tools to make this project! These are what I used, but it is possible to make this piece without owning all of these tools.
