Equipment needed for demonstrations:

- I prefer to use a Lathe with 1 1/4 x 8 spindle and electronic variable speed, not a mini, that is **not** on wheels or a pallet. (I'm quite short!)
- Please let me know ahead of time what type of lathe the demo will be done on, especially if it differs from my preference above.
- The Triangular Box needs a full size lathe with electronic variable speed.
- A short tool rest is also very good to have! I will bring my own, but it may not fit the demo lathe.
- Grinder with Wolverine platform and good quality, fine grit wheel (80-120), on the left side of the grinder.
- I will bring all the wood, chucks, equipment, etc that I need for the demos.
- A white board to draw on during the demo.
- A projection screen for my projector, **in addition** to the monitor or screen that the video of the demo is shown on. Switching back and forth is not a good solution. I plan to offer a continuous digital presentation during the demonstration, as an alternative to doing drawings.
- Superglue: ultra thin, medium (or thick), and accelerator
- I will email my handout sheets for you to copy or post to the club's website.
- I need **at least an hour** to set up before the demo starts. More time is more better! This can be early the same day, or the day before. Please be sure that we can have access to the hall for set up.
- A microphone is good, especially if the room is large.
- I will bring a digital projector and computer to project an illustration of my demonstration. I will need some kind of projection screen for this. It can be a large white board, actual projection screen, or smooth white wall.
- The best view of my demonstrations is an overhead camera with zoom.
